ADDITIONAL RULES AND POLICIES

Please share this information with your group's chaperones.

The Museum requests that adults act as role-models to children for interacting with the staff and other overnight participants, as well as respecting the property of the Museum and of other overnight participants. Please observe all standard Museum rules and regulations and obey the regulations outlined in this document concerning eating locations, smoking, quiet times, and lights-out times. Adults are responsible for the behavior of their group's children **AT ALL TIMES**. Violations of the Overnight Policies may result in staff requesting the violators to leave the Museum.

- Adults must effectively chaperone their children at all times.
- Butterfly Haven regulations must be followed.
- Please walk at all times.
- Please do not play on stairwells or in elevators.
- Participants must wear shoes at all times when walking around the Museum (even at night).
- Please keep all sleeping gear rolled up and stored in assigned locations until "Bedtime Preparation" hours begin.
- Please keep all exits clear at all times. Exits and walkways will be marked in sleeping areas. Staff will ensure the exits and walkways are clear before the "Lights Out" time.
- No food or drink is permitted in exhibits or sleep areas. Please eat in the designated areas only: the North Gallery on Level 2 and the School Group Lunch Room on Level 1.
- Alcohol is strictly prohibited.
- Please do not bring electronics or appliances such as TVs, VCRs and DVD players; laptop computers; coffee pots and hot plates; and pets (guide animals are exempt)
- Please do not smoke except in the designated area outside the main lobby. The Nature Museum is a smoke-free facility.
- Please observe all lights out and quiet time from 11:00 p.m. to 7:00 a.m.
- If you have a concern within your sleeping area or an emergency within your group, please notify a staff member.
- Should an emergency arise, you and your group will be instructed by staff on actions to be taken. Please follow their instructions promptly and quietly.
- Groups must clean up after themselves within their designated sleep area. Please have your sleep area cleared by 9:00 a.m.

Please remember that this event is designed primarily for children in youth groups. Safety is our number one priority. Groups not adhering to these policies and procedures or to the safety concerns of Museum staff or Security personnel may be asked to leave at any time, without a refund.
